

SAINT ISAAC JOGUES PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
November 5, 2015

Dinner meeting opened with a prayer by Fr. Darrell

Old business:

Laura reported that the Barrister Garden dinner went very well. 441 attended and many positive comments were given. The closing mass was attended by approximately 900.

The welcome mass and installation of SAM religious articles is scheduled for Nov. 22. There will be a light reception after the 11:30 Mass which is being coordinated by Christian Service.

Fr. Darrell reported that the large statue of St. Angela in front of the church will not be moved to Resurrection Cemetery. Father suggested that it be moved to SIJ and be placed in front of the south wall of the gym with a garden planted in front of it. The SAM altar is too large for the sacristy at SIJ. It will be placed in storage for the time being. Other statues and religious items will be brought to SIJ. A few parishioners have requested various items from the church that were purchased by their family. Father will oblige, if possible. Fr. Darrell has asked Greg to remove the cornerstone and the time capsule from St. Angela's. If this can be done by November 22 the items will be presented at the welcome Mass. Fr. Darrell also suggested that a display box be made to hold the contents and be placed in the newly-named St. Angela hall.

Steve gave an update on the construction. The handicapped spaces have been repainted and the drop off zone has been striped and signage was added. The PPC had requested that additional handicapped parking be created in the third row. Due to miscommunication the additional spots were not added. Various PPC members will monitor the need for the additional spots over the next couple of weeks. The railing repairs have been completed and the contractor, Tom Badke from Reliable Fence donated his services (approximately \$5000 in value). He will be publically thanked.

Father Darrell will be getting 3 bids on replacing (or repairing) the driveway and the curb redesign. It was noted that assistance by the ushers has not been consistent. Father asked Vince to have a sign made and posted in the Ushers' room as a reminder that they need to be available to assist those needing help up the ramp.

Lou Anne asked how we will know what percent of SAM parishioners transitioned to SIJ. Vince stated that collections and envelopes used will be the only way to determine this. Parishioners that have registered at another parish should call SIJ to be removed from the list. A review of registered parishioners will be done and those no longer contributing will be sent a letter requesting that they notify the parish office if they wish to remain as a registered parishioner.

New business:

The garage sale is scheduled for the weekend of November 14-15. Large items will be priced and smaller items will be sold on a donation basis. Greg Ruvolo is coordinating the sale.
